



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Camp Lenape

Registration Information

- Camp runs for 1 week sessions beginning July 11 through August 19. Children may sign up for a week or any combination of weeks.
- On-line registration is open. Mail-in and walk-in registration opens May 10 in Byram. Walk-in registration is held May 25 and June 6 evenings in Stanhope. Payments must be received at least one week in advance.
- Byram and Netcong residents register in Byram. *Please make checks payable to: Byram Recreation, 10 Mansfield Drive, Byram, NJ 07874.* Stanhope residents register in Stanhope. *Please make checks payable to Stanhope Borough, 77 Main Street, Stanhope, NJ 07874.*
- Fees are calculated per week and are not prorated.
- Fees are not refundable without a physician's note showing inability to participate in this activity.
- Please indicate date of birth and grade entering in the fall on registration form. Participants are expected to be the required age and/or grade by the start of the program.
- Activities cannot be reserved by phone call or email. Use registration form located on this flyer or Byram and Netcong residents may register online. Online registration is the only form of registration available for Byram and Netcong residents between May 2 – May 9.
- Online registration is available at www.byramtwp.org. Go to 'Community' and then select 'Recreation Programs' from the drop-down menu. Once there, click on the URL link for "Online Recreation Program Registration". (Note, you end up doing this twice). Once you are on the new webpage for Online Registration you need to log in (create a new account if necessary). Then after you are logged in, go to the top and select 'Search and Shop', then select 'Activities' from the drop-down menu. Afterward you select the criteria for your search, locate the program to register for, and click through which household members are being registered and fill out payment information when checking out. Note: you must know your bank routing number for EFT payments.

Teacher and Counselor & Counselor in Training Applications

Applications are available for certified teachers to teach Art, Music & Theater, Science, Health and Wellness and Physical Education. Applications are available for Counselors who have completed at least one year of college. Counselors lead an age group of children on trips and act as an aide for their age group during activities. CIT's or Counselors in Training entering grades 10 – 12 are expected to attend pre and in-season training and assist with children in various age groups. 

Parents are welcome to join their child on the 1/2 day trips/events for a fee of \$15 on a space available basis, but must register in advance. Transportation on the bus may or may not be available. Parents may meet the group at the Hackettstown pool and pay their own admission of \$6.

Fridays are full day trips. (Week 4—Wed). Parents, CIT's and 4 and 5 year olds are welcome on the full day trips on a space available basis. 4 & 5 year olds must be accompanied by a parent/guardian. CIT'S must have a buddy. The fee is \$40 for the child or CIT and \$45 for the adult except weeks 4 & 6 which is \$75 for the child or CIT and \$80 for the adult.

All the above mentioned non-camp participants must register by Monday for these trips. Bus transportation may or may not be available.
