These documents can be mailed to the above address or faxed to (609) 633-6056. According to N.J.A.C 5:96-3.5, once the petition is deemed complete, Netcong Borough shall publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation within seven days of issuance of a notification letter by COAH. Once COAH receives the necessary documents, COAH staff will continue to work with Netcong Borough on a substantive review of your third round growth share plan to culminate in final approval.
