Dear Parents:

With the opening of this new school year, we would like to remind all (and point out to new) of the following rules when dropping off children at school:

- Do not stop for any reason on the school side of College Rd (No Stopping or Standing Zone).
- Do not double park to discharge passengers. Pull completely over to the curb so as not to block traffic.
- Do not park on the crosswalk lines.
- If the crossing guard stops your vehicle to allow children to cross, do not allow your children to exit your vehicle. You **MUST** still park for this purpose.
- You must make a complete stop at posted stop signs.
- Please take note of no parking and limited time parking signs.
- Do not engage in a confrontation with the Crossing Guard that is directing traffic.
- Please follow the instructions of the crossing guard that is in the rear of the school as well as the guard posted on College Road.
- No entrance into the front parking lot (coned).

The above listed are violations of New Jersey Statutes and could result in a summons being issued. In addition, we would like to suggest the following:

- Do not pass vehicles that are in the process of parking.
Children are crossing and would not be inclined to look to the left after crossing the center line.
- Please try to limit your time parked in front of the school to a minimum.
Remember, other parents must park there too.
- Improper parking and discharge of passengers from a No Parking Zone.

Police Officers will be in marked and unmarked police vehicles as well as on foot patrol and will be issuing summons for any motor vehicle infractions.

We are committed to making the area a safe place for your children and would really appreciate your cooperation.

However, due to the importance we place on the safety of your children, this letter will likely serve as the only warning the Netcong Police will issue.
