Home Prevention Tips

**Drain Standing Water–
Check out some tips to help
reduce Mosquito habitats!**

1. Clean out gutters and drains.
2. Dispose of old tires. Drill holes in tire swings.
3. Drain standing water from pool covers.
Make sure pool covers are pulled tight.
Keep pools chlorinated
4. Flip over plastic children's pools when not in use.
5. Drain or change water every four days in containers such as pet dishes, flower pots, wheelbarrows, birdbaths, decorative pools and rain barrels.
6. Decorative pools and rain barrels can be stocked with a special type of fish that feed on mosquito larvae.
7. Cover garbage and recycling containers.
Remove any loose garbage from your yard such as bottle caps, pie plates, food containers, etc.
8. Check swing sets, lawn furniture and decorations, toys, etc. for standing water.
